NAME AND LOCATION OF COLLEGE OR VOCATIONAL SCHOOL ENROLLED:

1. Must be a paternal and dependent child of a Mason who is a member of Worth Lodge #194, Sylvester, Georgia, in good standing, or if father is deceased, was in good standing at the time of his death.
2. Applicant must be a High School graduate or have GED certificate, enrolled and attending an accredited college or vocational school.
3. After the initial semester of school, a copy of college or vocational school records in reference to subjects taken, hours, grades, etc. must be presented to the Secretary of Worth Lodge at the lodge office, or mailed to him at the lodge address or emailed to him at postmaster@worthlodge194.org. This information must be received on or before the second Mondays in February and September, **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Applicant must be passing at least 10 hours (or equivalent) per semester with a GPA of 2.5 or better. All scholarship applications must be approved by the Scholarship Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee at their discretion.
4. Scholarship payments will be for a maximum of 10 semesters or until the applicant reaches age 24. The amount of payment will be based on the number of semester hours successfully completed commensurate with the number of applications received and approved. Maximum payments will be \$500 for vocational school, \$800 for two-year college, and \$1000 for four-year college.
5. Scholarship checks will be issued to the Father of applicant during the regular communication of the Lodge on the second meeting night of the month as follows:

First Semester – 4th Monday night in September

Second Semester – 4th Monday night in February

The Father of the applicant **MUST BE PRESENT** to receive the check(s).
